

NOTICE OF RACE
100 MILER, JULY 25, 2009
M&M YACHT CLUB, MENOMINEE MI.

1. The Race will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
2. Eligibility:
 - 2.1 The 100 Miler Race is open to all LMPHRF and cruising yachts that meet U.S. Sailing qualifications.
 - 2.2 Eligible yachts may enter by submitting the following:
 - a. A completed Entry Form and current certificate of liability insurance.
 - b. A valid LMPHRF certificate. (Yachts without a current LMPHRF certificate will be allowed to enter and race, but will be assessed a 6 sec/mile penalty.)
 - 2.3 Completed entries will be accepted at one of the following locations, on or before the dates and times specified:
 - a. If entering by U.S. Mail: (PO Box will be last checked at 1500 hrs on 7-24-09.

 - 3.2 Course 2 (Non-Spinnaker, 35.8nm) \$75.00 if received by 7-11-09 \$100.00 if after 7-11-09
4. Schedule of Events
 - 4.1 Sign In and Late Entries.
Friday July 24, 2009, 1100 to 1800 hrs Central Daylight Time
The yacht's owner, or an owner's representative, must sign-in at the Registration Desk in the M&M Yacht Club. Late entries will also be accepted at the Registration Desk during the hours shown. Yachts failing to sign-in may not be scored, at the discretion of the Race Committee.

 - 4.3 Other Events:
Friday July 24th, Round the Island Warm Up Race.

Saturday July 25th, 0600 to 0800 hrs, Breakfast available at the M&M Yacht Club.
Saturday July 25th, 0900 hrs, First Warning
Saturday July 25th, 1800 hrs, Cocktails and Barbeque
Saturday July 25th, Evening, Results when available and Awards.
5. Measurement
 - 5.1 Yachts without a valid LMPHRF will be rated by a measurer appointed by the 100 Miler Chairperson, and assessed a 6 second per mile penalty.
6. Sailing Instructions will be posted on the M&M Yacht Club website, and distributed to all yachts that have completed registration on July 24th, 2009.
7. The Racing Area will be the waters of Green Bay. The Start and Finish will be East of the Northeast corner of the Menominee breakwall.
8. The Race will be scored by corrected time, based on course sailed, and class entered. Time allowances will be based on time on distance expressed in nautical miles.
9. Penalties will be assessed in accordance with The Racing Rules of Sailing, including published revisions.
10. Prizes: To be determined. Trophies will be awarded during the evening of July 25th, 2009.
